

# St. Teresa of Lisieux Catholic Primary Mission Statement



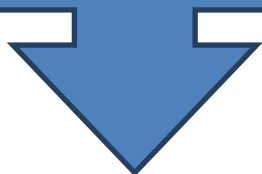
'All things are possible when we love, learn and grow together'

Provide an inspiring and memorable learning experience, empowering our children to value their own and others' learning.



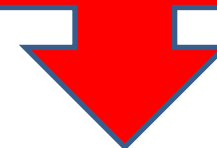
### By:
